	Transport to Healthcare Information Centre (THInC)	Develop, in a phased manner across the region, an integrated appointment booking, transport scheduling and vehicle/ transportation deployment system where personnel, vehicles and computer systems would be "pooled" to provide an efficient, reliable and safe mechanism to enable patients attend healthcare facilities. NHSG to provide accommodation and running costs for first year. SAS to meet one staff salary with partners contributing to share of remaining salary costs. Any funding support from the Scottish Government unlikely to be known until early 2013.		THInC helpline officially opened in Elgin on 31 Jan and second member of staff appointed. Help being given on transport options for appointments at the outpatient eye clinic and dental school at ARI and clinics run in the Moray area. THInC being promoted within the pilot areas and monitoring and evaluation of the trial ongoing. Plans for region-wide roll being progressed.		↑
