A 2012 survey in Aberdeen City Centre indicated that 77% of all vehicles delivering on Union Street, or to the main city centre retail centres were Euro 4 or above, and highlighted the important role of smaller vehicles in freight distribution in the city centre.

# FREIGHT IN NORTH EAST SCOTLAND



Aberdeen Harbour handles some 8,000 vessel arrivals every year and handles more than four million tonnes of freight.

The sea freight services provided by the Harbour are key to the economy of the North East, contributing an annual total of around £1.5bn, supporting 12,000 full-time jobs. Harbour operations connect the North East with more than 45 countries around the world.

Peterhead Harbour handled approximately 1,000 tonnes of freight in 2013. It has recently benefited from substantial investment in Smith Quay, which has 200-metre berth area and a depth of 10-metres.
